



## IMPORTANT: LDYC COVID – 19 RESPONSE 2022

LDYC Members:

As Provincial and local officials across the country have eliminated COVID-19 restrictions, we wanted to take this opportunity to communicate the health and safety standards that will exist within the LDYC for the **2022** season.

While we are optimistic that widespread adoption of vaccines has reduced the spread of Covid-19 it still poses a real and ongoing public health issue for many people within our club and the wider community. We must continue to do all we can to stay safe, and we thank you for your assistance in doing so.

During these uncertain times, the LDYC Board of Directors will always prioritize the safety and well being of our members. In 2020 and 2021 we imposed a strict lockdown on all club related activities. Although we will remain vigilant, we feel that it is time to move forward in a generally vaccinated community. ***There will be risks, but it is now time for individuals to assess their own tolerance and manage interactions on a personal level. The LDYC will continue to support our members but will no longer dictate / restrict their actions.***

As we have since the beginning of the pandemic, we continue to ground our approach in recommendations from the Province of Saskatchewan and the Saskatchewan Ministry of Health.

### Responsible and Respectful use of LDYC facilities:

#### General

- While the LDYC will take all reasonable precautions to protect our members, your presence at the LDYC is ***entirely at your own risk***. The yard, harbour, marina, launch, and docks are all public spaces over which the LDYC has no control.
- Do not, under any circumstances, come to the Club / Marina if you have any symptoms of COVID-19 or if you are living with a person who has such symptoms.
- If you have tested positive for Covid-19 respect fellow LDYC members through strict adherence to official health policies regarding your return to the general population.
- Members are responsible for keeping themselves informed of COVID-19 procedures when they are published and for conforming to them when coming to LDYC.
- ***Respect all LDYC members*** by following physical distancing, sanitation and vaccination measures recommended by government health officials.
- LDYC members are responsible for their guests and must ensure that they always comply with LDYC Covid-19 safety standards.

### Facilities / Equipment

- All LDYC facilities and equipment will be available for normal use. Please follow proper sanitation procedures before and after their use.

### Social / Events / Programs

- The **Sailing School** for the 2022 season is **scheduled for Aug 22 - 25**.
- **Club events** have been scheduled.
- **Racing Events** have been scheduled

It is the sincere hope of the Executive that the LDYC can move forward safely without restrictions. It is now time for individual members to take responsibility for their own actions while considering the needs of others. There are many individuals that remain extremely vulnerable to Covid-19 so ***we ask that LDYC members function with the utmost respect and consider how their behaviour will affect others.***
